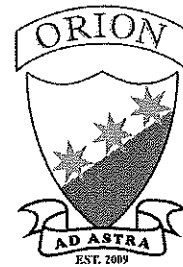

LOCKERS


There are still lockers available for rent at R 200.00 per term or R 600.00 for the rest of the year.

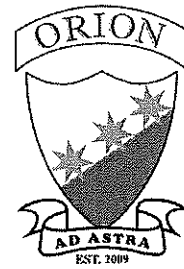

If possible, please donate empty 2 litre ice cream containers


Lockers are available for rent at R200.00 per term or R 800.00 for the year.
