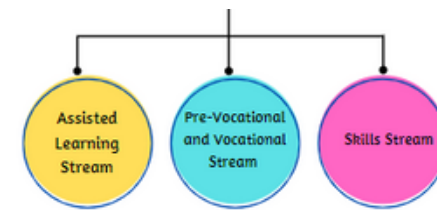

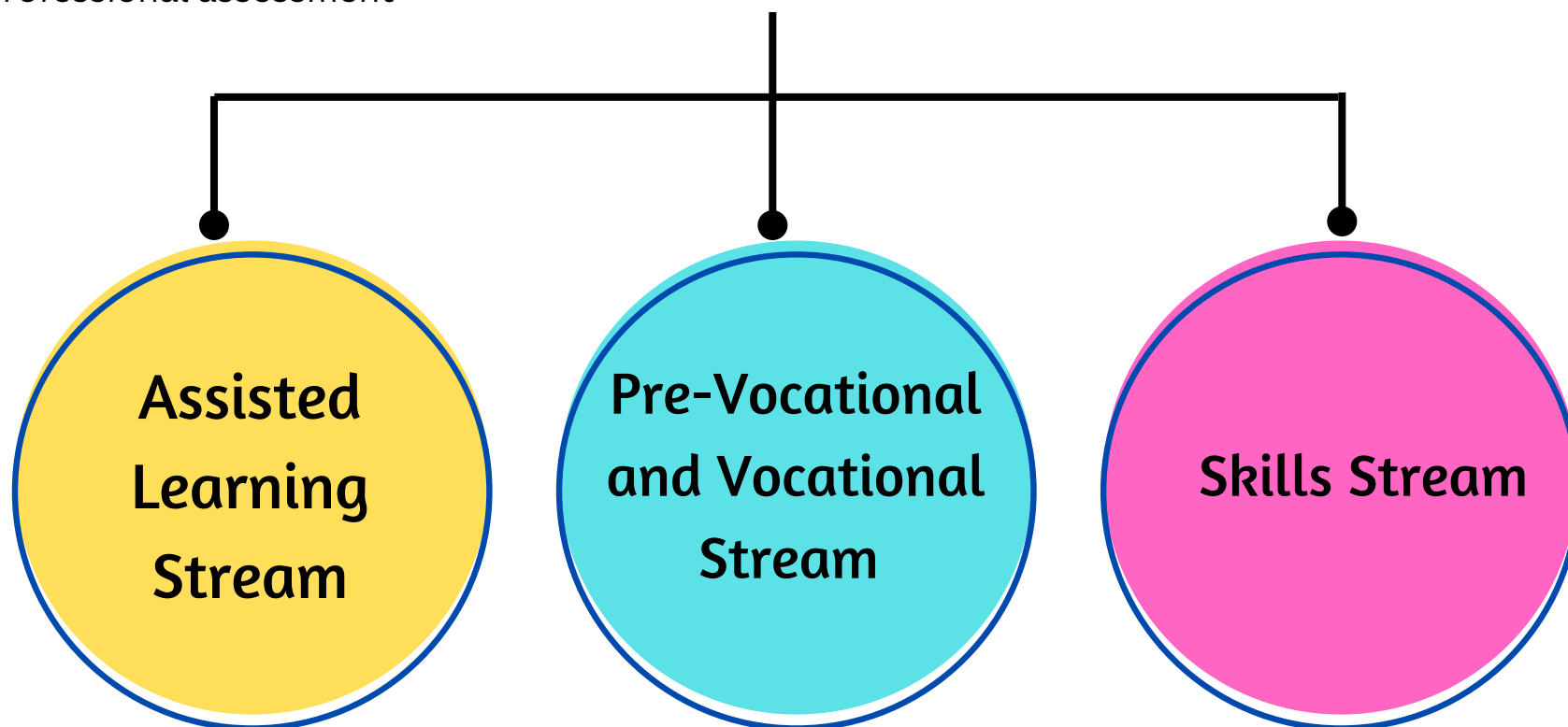


We are **not** a typical Assisted Learning and Remedial School.

Assisted Learning Stream

Curriculum: Mainstream CAPS curriculum

Grade 10 - 12 Subject Choices:

Core Maths/Maths Literacy, English HL, Afrikaans/Zulu FAL, Consumer Studies, Business Studies, Tourism, CAT

Outcome: National Senior Certificate (Bachelor's Diploma, Certificate, Accommodations Matric

What is next for these learners?

Depending on their NCS level, learners could further their studies at University or College.

Pre-Vocational and Vocational Stream

Curriculum: Mainstream CAPS curriculum with differentiated assessment until Grade 9

Grade 10 - 12 Subject Choices:

Level 2 - Level 3 Vocational: End-user computing

Level 4 Vocational: Technical support, and Early Childhood Development

Outcome: NQF Level 4

What is next for these learners?

Option to continue studies at NQF 5 level at College.

Skills Stream

Curriculum: Differentiated CAPS curriculum at the individual learner's level. Assisted through continuous assessment.

Individual Education/Support Plan Practical Skills Development, including Consumer Studies, Woodwork, Office administration, Agriculture and Job Shadowing.

Outcome: Functional literacy and numeracy, independence and readiness for work.

What is next for these learners? Option to join Living Links (training for the work environment), or move into other apprenticeships as parents see fit.
