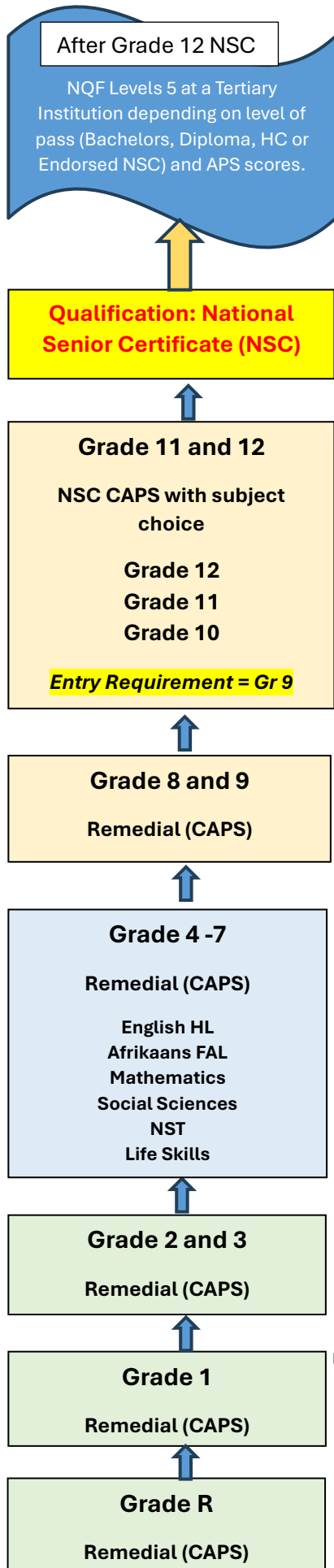
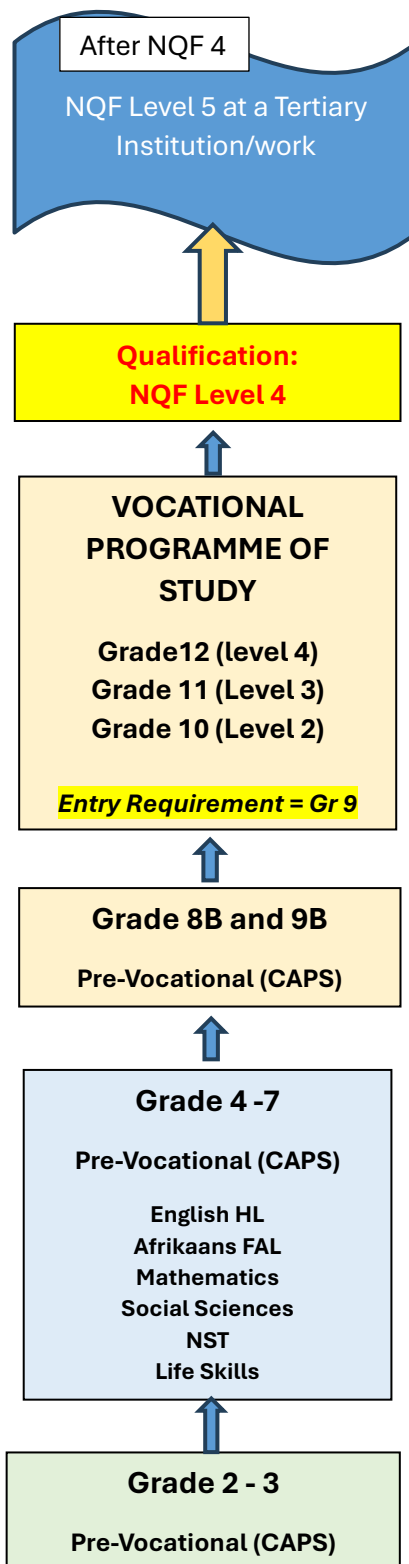


## NSC REMEDIAL STREAM



Learners who can manage with the CAPS curriculum with remedial support. Typically, learners with average cognitive profiles.

## PRE VOCATIONAL AND VOCATIONAL STREAM



Learners who are not able to keep up with the CAPS curriculum or age-related assessment at the required level of independence. They require considerable extra support and will benefit from flexible curriculum and learner paced approach. Typically, learners with below average/ borderline cognitive profiles.

## TECHNICAL OCCUPATIONAL SKILLS STREAM



Learners who are not able to keep up with the CAPS curriculum and age-related assessment despite the increased support and slower pace of the pre-vocational stream. These learners will benefit from the curriculum being differentiated to their individual level via an individualised education plan.

Typically, for learners with Mild Intellectual Difficulties (MID); low cognitive profiles and poor scholastic performance. Learners with Moderate to Severe Intellectual Difficulties are best catered to in a Special Needs School.
